Overview

Training Objectives

Completing the BDNA User Console Analyze Reports training will enable participants to:

- Access standard reports through User Console Search and Browse
- Understand different types of reports and when to use them
- Understand available types of Analyze cubes and attributes
- Create ad-hoc reports to review details of specific assets
- View higher and lower levels of the product taxonomy within the report
- Use drill-up and drill-down navigation to pass filters to a Detail Page, and Interactive Report
- Use standard dashboards or create custom dashboards
- Save reports for Public, Private, or Shared viewing

- Users with the role of User Console Reports Manager
- Users who develop reports to manage IT inventory data

Prerequisites

- Customer must already have BDNA User Console installed and configured
- Customer must have a current license for BDNA Analyze
- Before the workshop, customer must describe and submit an example of a reporting need or question, including the type of data and level of detail needed. The instructor will discuss and demonstrate these submissions in class based on current Analyze features
